Keith W. Hodgson has been a professor of music education at The University of the Arts in Philadelphia since 2016. As a high school instrumental

director for 26 years in NJ, Mr. Hodgson's experience with orchestra, concert, jazz, and marching bands is extensive. Mr. Hodgson is a past president of the NJMEA and NAfME's Eastern Division; Conductor of the South Jersey Area Wind Ensemble; a director with AMA for 25 years; and an active guest conductor and session presenter.

Stanley R. Schoonover has led the Fairfax Wind Sym. for all of its' 25 seasons as Music Director. His 32-year career in public school

education included eleven years as Music Supervisor for the Fairfax County Public Schools, widely regarded as one of America's foremost school music programs. Mr. Schoonover is a Past-President of the Virginia Band and Orchestra Directors Association and is an elected member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association.
