ITINERARY

Tuesday, July 23 - USA - PRAGUE

Group check-in at JFK Airport. Board transatlantic flight to Europe. Dinner, overnight, and breakfast onboard flight.

Wednesday, July 24 - PRAGUE

Morning arrival in Prague. Transfer to rehearsal facility. After a light rehearsal, free time for independent lunch in the city center. Your guided tour will view sights such as Wenceslas Square, St. Nicholas Church and the 14th century Astronomical Clock, which adorns the Old Town Hall. Cross the statue-lined Charles Bridge, the oldest bridge in the city, dating from 1357. After a dinner with Folkloric entertainment, return to the hotel for overnight.



Thursday, July 25 - PRAGUE

After a morning rehearsal and independent lunch, continue your guided tour of the "City of a Thousand Spires" and the capital of the Czech Republic. Enjoy an evening dinner cruise on the Vltava River. Overnight in Prague.

Friday, July 26 - PRAGUE

After your last rehearsal, your afternoon is free for lunch and further exploring. Enjoy your inaugural concert in the beautiful Prague Museum of Art. After the concert, relax with dinner and overnight in Prague.

Saturday, July 27 - SALZBURG

Travel South to UNESCO historic site Cesky Krumlov for lunch. Continue through the Bohemian countryside to Salzburg, Austria: the city of *Sound of Music* and Mozart. After checking into the hotel, enjoy a stroll through Mirabell Gardens. Dinner and overnight in Salzburg.



Sunday, July 28 - SALZBURG

Today's guided tour of Salzburg will introduce you to the history and many of the sights of this wonderful city. Free time to visit Mozart's birthplace and the imposing fortress which dominates the Salzburg landscape. An evening concert performance is planned. Dinner and overnight in Salzburg.

Monday, July 29 - VIENNA

Travel east for a sobering visit to WWII Mauthausen Concentration Camp. After a lunch stop in Melk, arrive in Vienna, "The City of Music". Your guided tour will better acquaint you with the haunts and sites of musical greats such as Strauss, Beethoven and Mahler. Visit the graveyard where many of the composers now reside. Tonight, attend an orchestral performance in a beautiful Vienna Concert Hall. Dinner and overnight in Vienna.

Tuesday, July 30 - VIENNA

This morning's short choir performance at St. Stephen's Cathedral is followed by a tour of the internationally renowned Vienna State Opera House. Free time to shop or take part in a Viennese institution: pastry and coffee at a café. Afternoon tour of lavish Schönbrunn Palace, the summer home of the Hapsburgs. Tonight, enjoy a special Viennese dinner with waltzers and musical entertainment. Overnight in Vienna.



Wednesday, July 31 - BUDAPEST

Afternoon arrival in the city of Budapest, built along the Danube River. Board your coaches and transfer into the city center. Tonight's welcome dinner features folkloric entertainment. Overnight in Budapest.



Thursday, August 1 - BUDAPEST

Breakfast followed by a sightseeing tour of Buda and Pest, the two original sections of the city. The view from the palace is a wonderful panorama including Parliament, Heroes Square, Matthias Church and Elizabeth Bridge. Free time this afternoon for further exploring. Dinner and overnight in Budapest.

Friday, August 2 - BUDAPEST AIRPORT - USA

Transfer to Budapest Airport for return to United States via a scheduled flight. Welcome Home!
